Read this *continued*

Finding just the right plant is an essential part of a successful landscape plan. Factors such as intended use, weather tolerance, color, maintenance, and expense must all be taken into account.

Plants must have proper nutrition in order to grow properly. For information about plant nutrition, locate the *Agriscience: Fundamentals and Applications* textbook and read the section titled "Plant Nutrition" on pages 310-315. Also, be sure to take notice of the chart on page 316, which describes some common mineral excesses and deficiencies.
