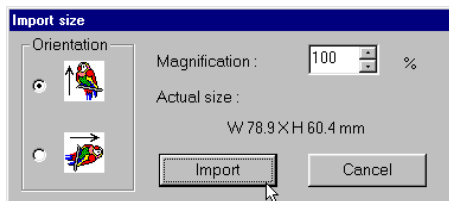

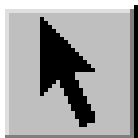

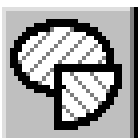

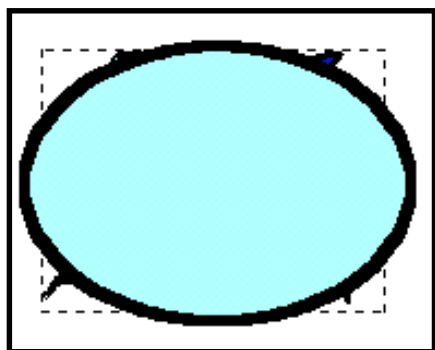

Click the **F**ile menu, **I**mport, from **D**esign Center, then click the Import button in the Import size window (Figure 4-3). This brings your fish design into the Layout and Editing program.

### Saving the File



Now go ahead and save this version of the file onto your floppy by clicking the **F**ile menu, **S**ave, and, in the Save As window, use the same file name (initialsfish), but leave the .pes extension.

### Resizing the Graphic



Because you're going to put other elements into your logo, resize the fish image by using the Selection tool (Figure 4-4), clicking on one of the corner handles of the image, and resizing it down to about 70 mm wide and 53 mm high. Look at the bottom left corner of the window for image dimensions.

### Drawing an Ellipsis

Now you're going to draw an ellipsis (a flattened circle, like a football) around the fish and plant. But before you actually draw the ellipsis, you want to define the colors of the outline and region.



Click the Circle/Arc tool (Figure 4-5), and verify that the Circle drop-down menu has circle in it, that the line color is black and set for ZigZag Stitch (Figure 4-6).



Change the region color to whatever you wish, but make sure it's set for Fill Stitch.



Since the Circle/Arc tool is already selected, drag a circle around the fish image so that it covers most of the existing image (Figure 4-7). When you release the mouse button, the ellipsis will cover the fish.
