

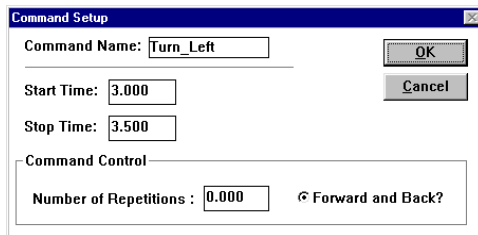

Copying and Pasting Commands

Starting at Storyboard #3, the Centaur will walk toward the right in the same manner as he did earlier, arms swinging, tail wagging. Since we've already issued these commands, there's no need to follow all of the procedures again to simply change the times. Therefore, we're going to copy the two existing commands, and paste them with different times.

2

Select the Centaur, then click the Walk_Wag 0:00 2:00 command (**Figure 6-1**), click the Script menu, Copy Command(s), then click the Script menu again, and select Paste Command(s). *This, then, opens the Command Setup window.*

In the Command Setup window, change the Start Time to 3:00, the Stop Time to 5:00 and click OK. *Even though you didn't have the option to change the number of repetitions, it kept the same number (2) as the original. Once you click OK, you'll notice that the command is there twice, but with different times.*

Now do the same thing with the Walk2_ 0:00 2:00 command, giving it a new Start Time of 3:00 and a Stop Time of 5:00.

Issuing the Final Two Commands

5

Click the path point at 3 seconds and make sure the orientation is facing you.

6

Click the Script menu, Add Command, double-click Actions, double-click Head, select Turn_Left, then click OK.

7

In the Command Setup window, make the Start Time 3:00 and the Stop Time 3:50, check the Forward and Back button (**Figure 6-2**), then click OK.
